DON'T FORGET RECYCLE PULL-TABS

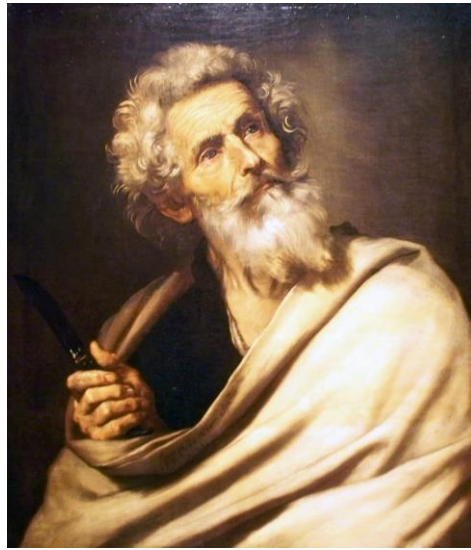
