THE DIOCESE OF QUINCY, IN PARTNERSHIP WITH ARCHBISHOP STEPHEN IN MYANMAR, HAS UNDERTAKEN A MISSION OF SUPPORT FOR SOME 60 ORPHANS IN MYANMAR. THEY WERE MADE ORPHANS BY VIOLENCE AND MURDER AGAINST CHRISTIAN VILLAGES IN THE REGION. DAVE BACKS IS OUR CONTACT PERSON WITH THE DIOCESE OF QUINCY, AND WE WILL BE HEARING MORE ABOUT THIS PROJECT THROUGH THE YEAR. IN THE MEANTIME, BISHOP MORALES HAS ASKED US TO CONSIDER MAKING A GIFT THIS HOLY SEASON FOR THESE ORPHANS. IF YOU FELL SO CALLED, PLEASE MAKE YOUR CHEQUES OUT TO ST. ANDREW'S AND PUT "ORPHANS" ON THE ITEM LINE. WE WILL THEN SEND A CHEQUE TO THE DIOCESE FOR FORWARDING TO MYANMAR
